

**Application to the Kenai Peninsula Borough Clerk for the Recall of
John Williams, Kenai Peninsula Borough Mayor**

John Williams has violated his oath of office while serving as Kenai Peninsula Borough Mayor. Specifically: Article One, Section Two of the Constitution of the State of Alaska, “All political power is inherent in the people. All government originates with the people, is founded upon their will only, and is instituted solely for the good of the people as a whole.”

John Williams has repeatedly ignored and even actively campaigned AGAINST the people’s expressed will, thus violating the intent clearly stated in our Constitution.

Furthermore, John Williams and his administrative staff have repeatedly and selectively ignored State Statute 29.26.110; and Kenai Peninsula Borough Code 4.130; by using obscure and irrelevant court decisions that poorly support his position, thereby denying citizens their Constitutional right to petition their government.

John Williams has shown open contempt for any law or group of people that do not support his position, and has left citizens with the option of either privately funded law suits against the Borough or his recall from office.
